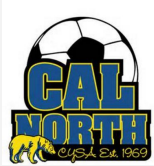
Soccer guidelines, is implementing the

following rules for heading:

- No heading at all (practices and games) for kids 10 years old or younger.
- Those kids who are 11 and 12 years old may head the ball a max of 15-20 times per week in practice...but no heading in games.
- Kids who are 13 years old and up have no heading restrictions.

## GAME DAY
